Identifies properties listed on the U.S. National Register of Historic Places to help insurers recognize historic buildings that may require specialized underwriting and claims handling. Historic properties often have higher repair and rebuilding costs due to preservation requirements, specialized materials, and modern building code upgrades.

- U.S. 50 states, DC, Puerto Rico and U.S. Virgin Islands.

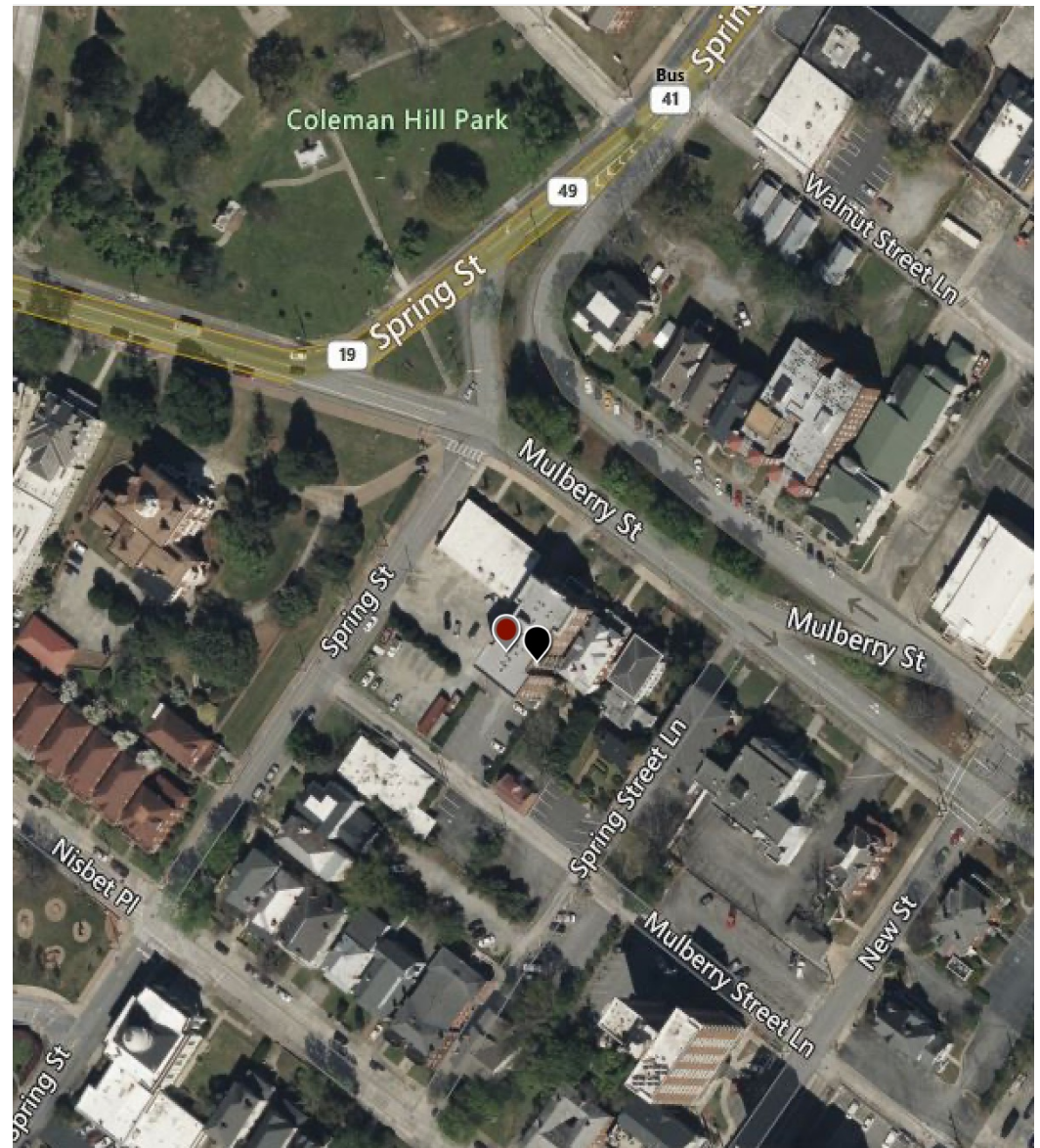
